PSD services and coronavirus

The clean tap water and sanitary sewer service provided by Hilton Head PSD are vital to public health in our community. The PSD team is committed to the continuity and effectiveness of our water and sewer systems in the face of all hazards, including the coronavirus pandemic. Your tap water is safe. Continue to use your tap water and sewer service as normal. In order to keep our staff and community safe at this time, the PSD's Customer Service Center is closed to walk-in and drive-thru service. Because of the importance of handwashing and sanitation at this time, the PSD will not be shutting off any customers' water until further notice. Our technicians remain available to assist you with emergency water and sewer service calls 24 hours a day. Please limit any calls for service to emergencies only, which means lack of water or a sewer backup.

According to the U.S. EPA and other public health agencies, coronavirus has not been detected in any drinking-water supplies and is not understood to be transmitted via tap water nor sewerage systems.

The virus is known to be effectively removed through the utility's standard chlorination of tap water and our maintenance of appropriate chlorine residual in the drinking water distribution system. Standard wastewater treatment processes, such as those conducted by the PSD at our Recycled Water Plant on Oak Park Drive, are known to remove coronavirus and other pathogens. Some studies have found that coronavirus is considered to be even more susceptible to our treatment processes than other pathogens we fight every day through our treatments, according to the EPA.

Water Quality Lab recognized again

Hilton Head PSD's water quality laboratory has once again been recognized as a Laboratory of Excellence as part of its annual certification by the S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC).

The independent agency that conducts DHEC's certification recognized the PSD lab "achieving 100% acceptable data" in a group of nearly 650 participating labs, according to a statement from the independent agency.

"This achievement is a demonstration of the superior quality of the laboratory," according to the statement.

The PSD water quality lab conducts thousands of tests annually on the quality of our tap water and treated recycled wastewater. The lab is led by PSD water quality chemists Scott Moffatt and Lee Barnard.

Directors Award given to PSD

The PSD completed a rigorous self-assessment of its drinking water system that was then reviewed by utility peers from around the country. PSD Water Quality Supervisor Scott Moffatt led the self-assessment program. The peer review team stated it was "particularly impressed with the broad representation of (PSD) staff participating in the self-assessment effort."

The Partnership for Safe Water is a voluntary effort among drinking water organizations, including the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and the American Water Works Association, and more than 300 water utilities. The goal is to optimize the protection of public health by improving utility performance beyond regulatory requirements.

"The PSD is committed to delivering the highest quality water to our customers 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
