VII. General Manager's Monthly Report

A. General Manager's Report

Key Discussion Points

- Mr. Nardi presented the December General Manager's Report. A copy of which is included in the agenda packet.
- Mr. Nardi informed the board about a potential community outreach project involving the historic tabby structure on Squire Pope Road across the street from the PSD's Squire Pope Well. The tabby site's owner, Mr. Thomas Barnwell, has asked Mr. Nardi and the PSD to be involved in a potential project related to public access to the site. Mr. Barnwell provided the former Rural Water District the site for the Squire Pope Well, which became the PSD's property when it acquired the assets of the Rural Water District in the 1990s. Mr. Nardi is meeting with members of the Barnwell family and Dr. Kim Cavanagh, Associate Professor of Anthropology at USCB, at the tabby site today to review the results of recent archaeology performed at the site.

B. Measurable Goals

Key Discussion Points

- At the October board meeting, Mr. Bell and Mr. Cutrer were assigned the task of preparing a draft outline of categories for measurable goals. The draft outline was presented to the board in November.
- At that time, the board accepted the report of the ad hoc committee and directed the general manager to report to the board with measurable goals that fall within the outline in December.
